

## **2020-2021 TASC District III Advisor Scholarships**

TASC District III will award up to two (2) TASC State Advisor's Workshop Scholarships up to \$250 each, and three (3) TASC District III Advisor's Workshop Scholarships, (who may bring 2 students each). They will be awarded to a Student Council Sponsor who is in financial need or new to the organization in order to help those sponsor(s) to further their professional development in student government and/or student council.

The following are the guidelines when applying for the scholarship:

1. The student council sponsor can only apply for one type of scholarship: TASC State Advisor's Workshop or TASC District III Advisor's Workshop.
  2. School must be in the TASC District III boundary.
  3. A new TASC District III sponsor (1-3 years as sponsor) may apply for either scholarship.
  4. Experienced TASC District III sponsor (4- current years) can only apply for the TASC State Advisor's Workshop.
  5. If applying for the TASC State Advisor's Workshop, the sponsor must provide receipts for registration and for hotel.
  6. Scholarship applications must have the advisor's signature and the principal's signature.
